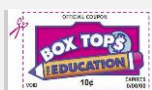

Bear Creek Camp's core purpose is to help individuals **explore, celebrate and grow in God's creation**. Bear Creek Camp staff and volunteers support that mission of experiential ministry by guiding campers to: have fun, share faith, build character, embrace adventure and cultivate community."
